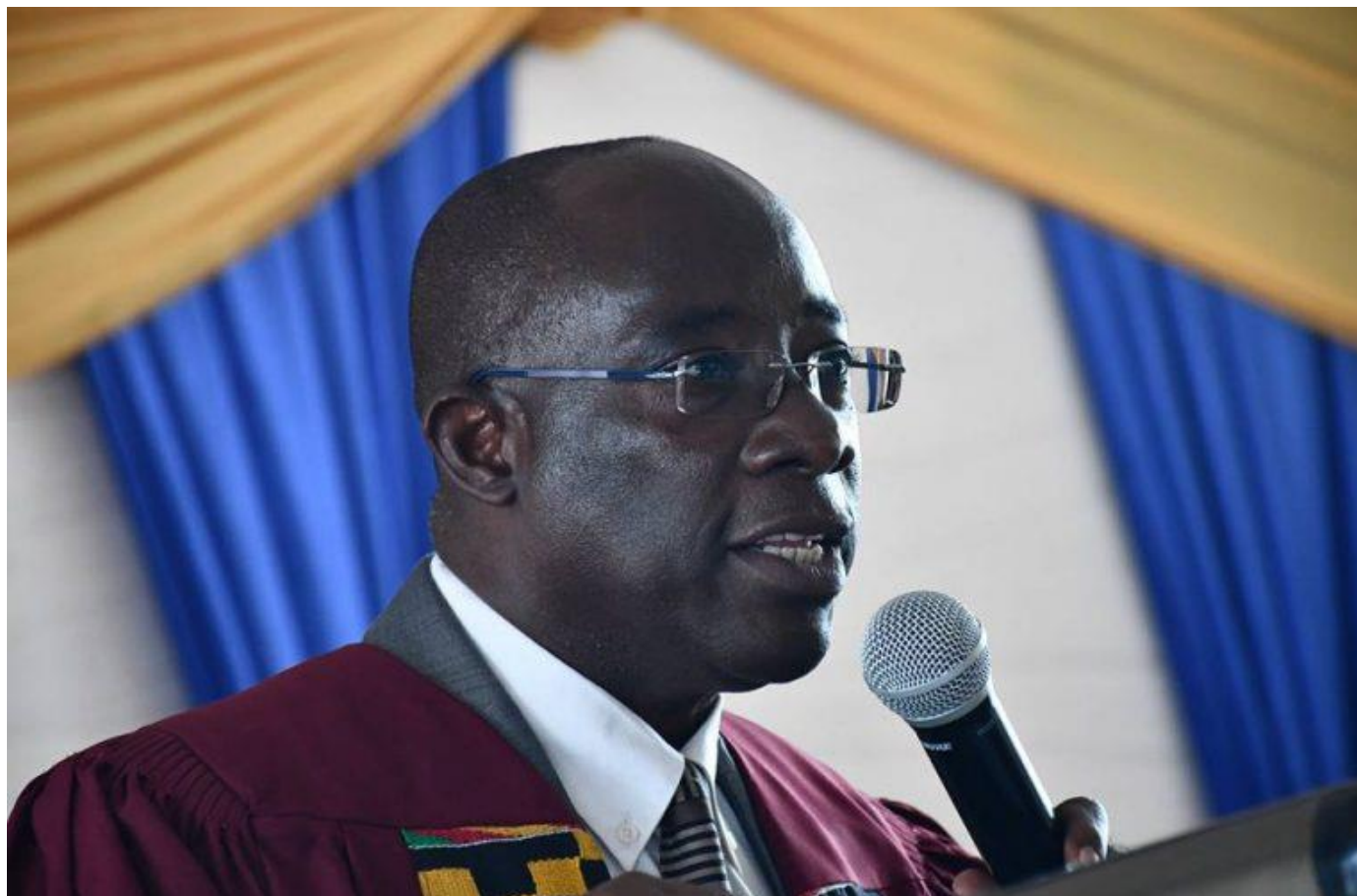
The University has seen such steady growth both in quality and expansion of its academic units and programmes in the past years that it has become the University of Choice in Ghana, West Africa.

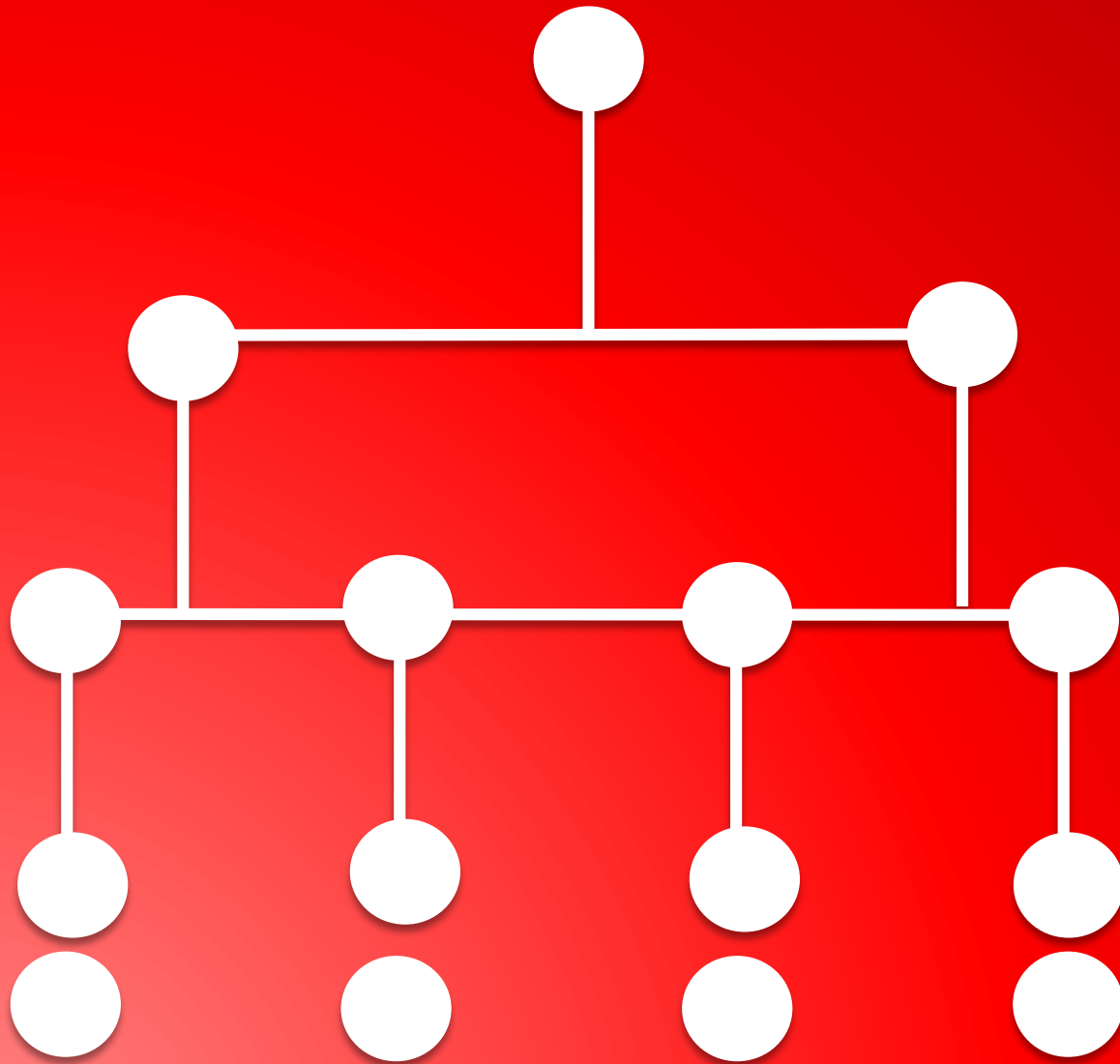

Structure



The University is governed by the University Council and operates on the Committee system.

The Vice-Chancellor, is the Academic and Administrative Head and Chief Disciplinary Officer of the University.

The Registrar acts as the Chief Administrative Officer of the University and also provides guidance for the framework within which policies are made.

There is also the Junior Common Room Committees (JCRC) with oversight responsibility by office of Dean of Students.

Brief History

The University was established in 1962 by Dr. Kwame Nkrumah, Ghana's first President, as a University College and given the mandate to train highly skilled professional teachers for Ghana's second-cycle institutions.

It gained autonomy to award degrees and certificates in 1972

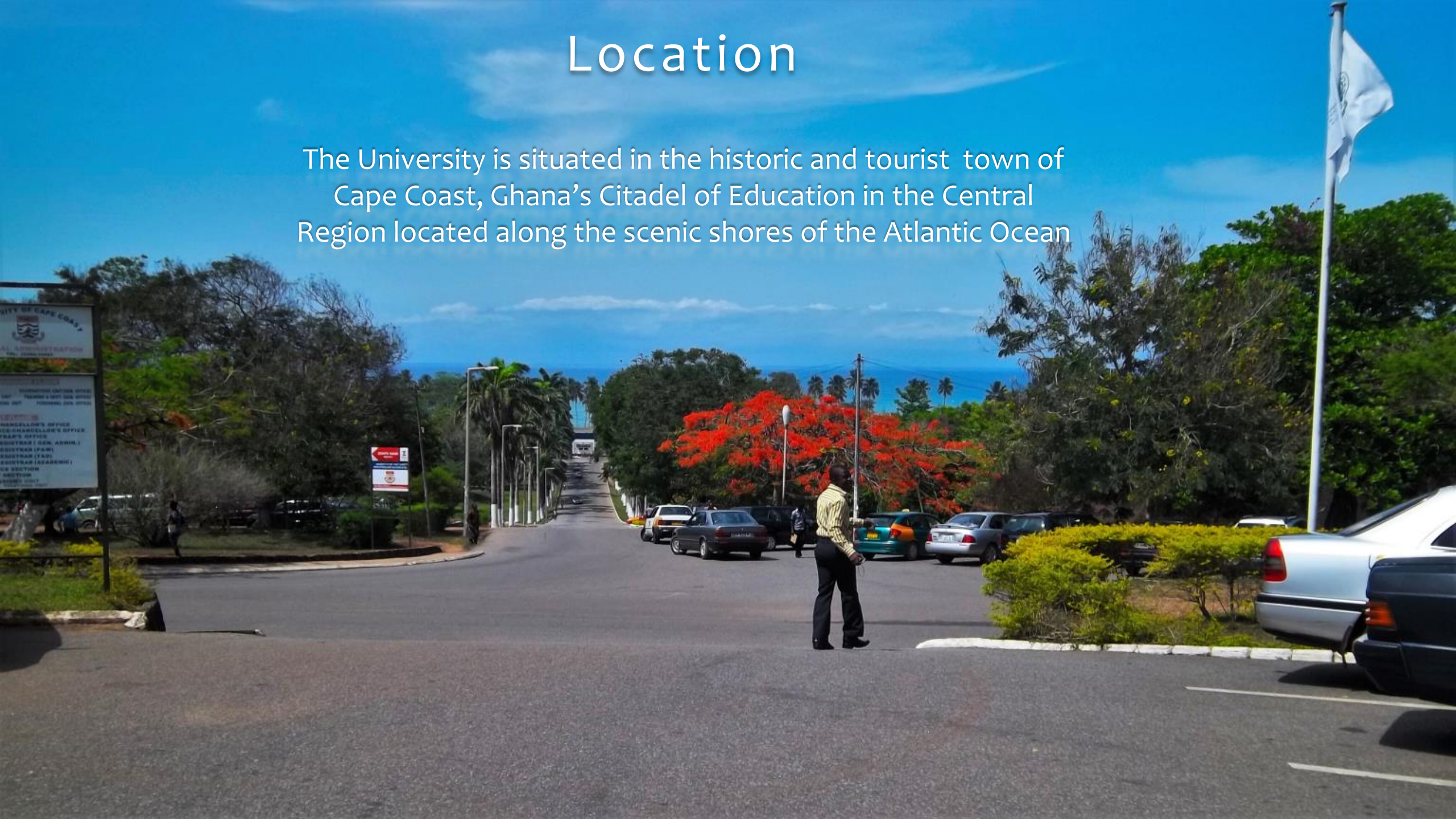
This statement of where the University sees itself in the future sets the tone for every strategic decision or choice that it has made.

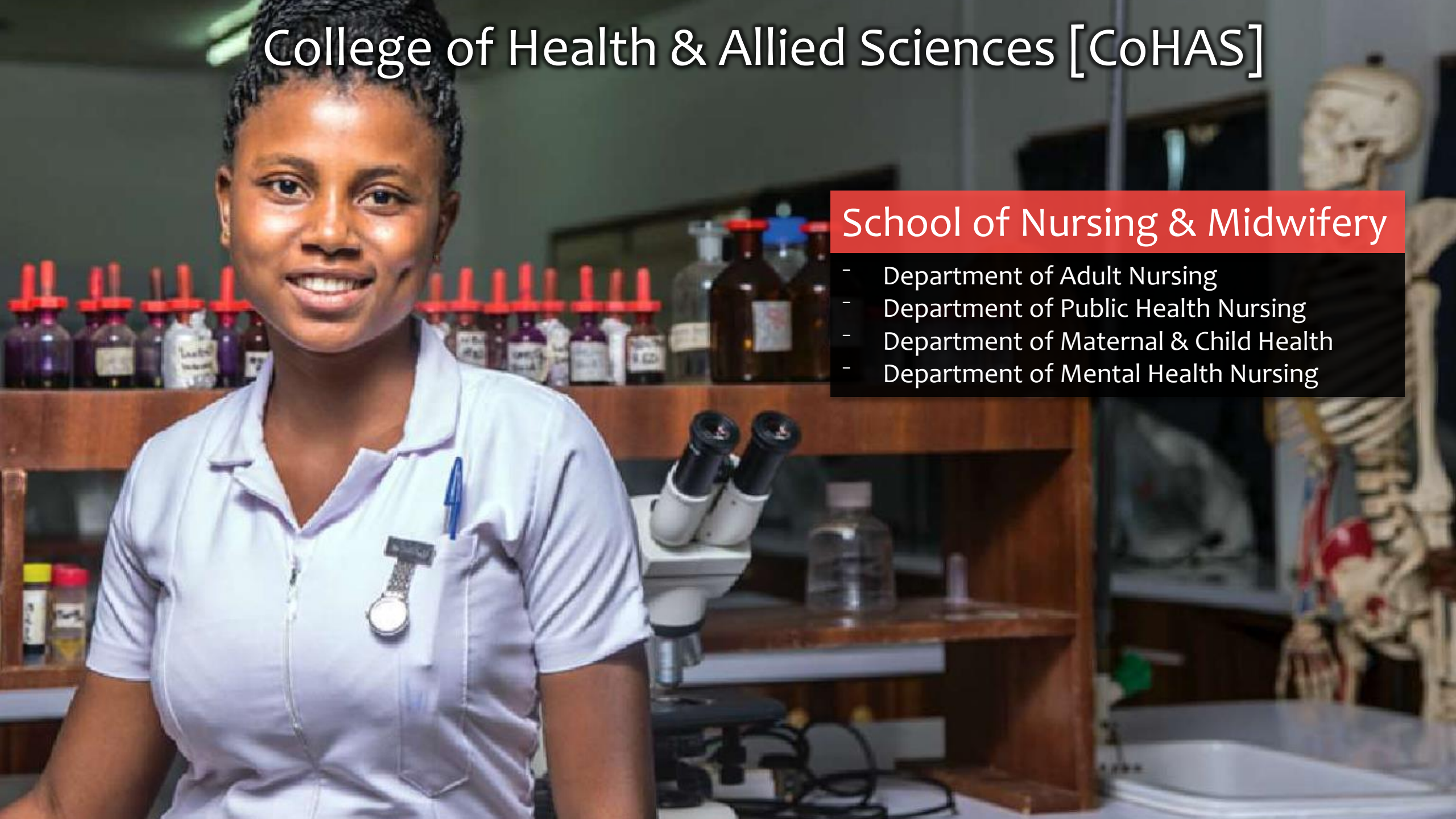

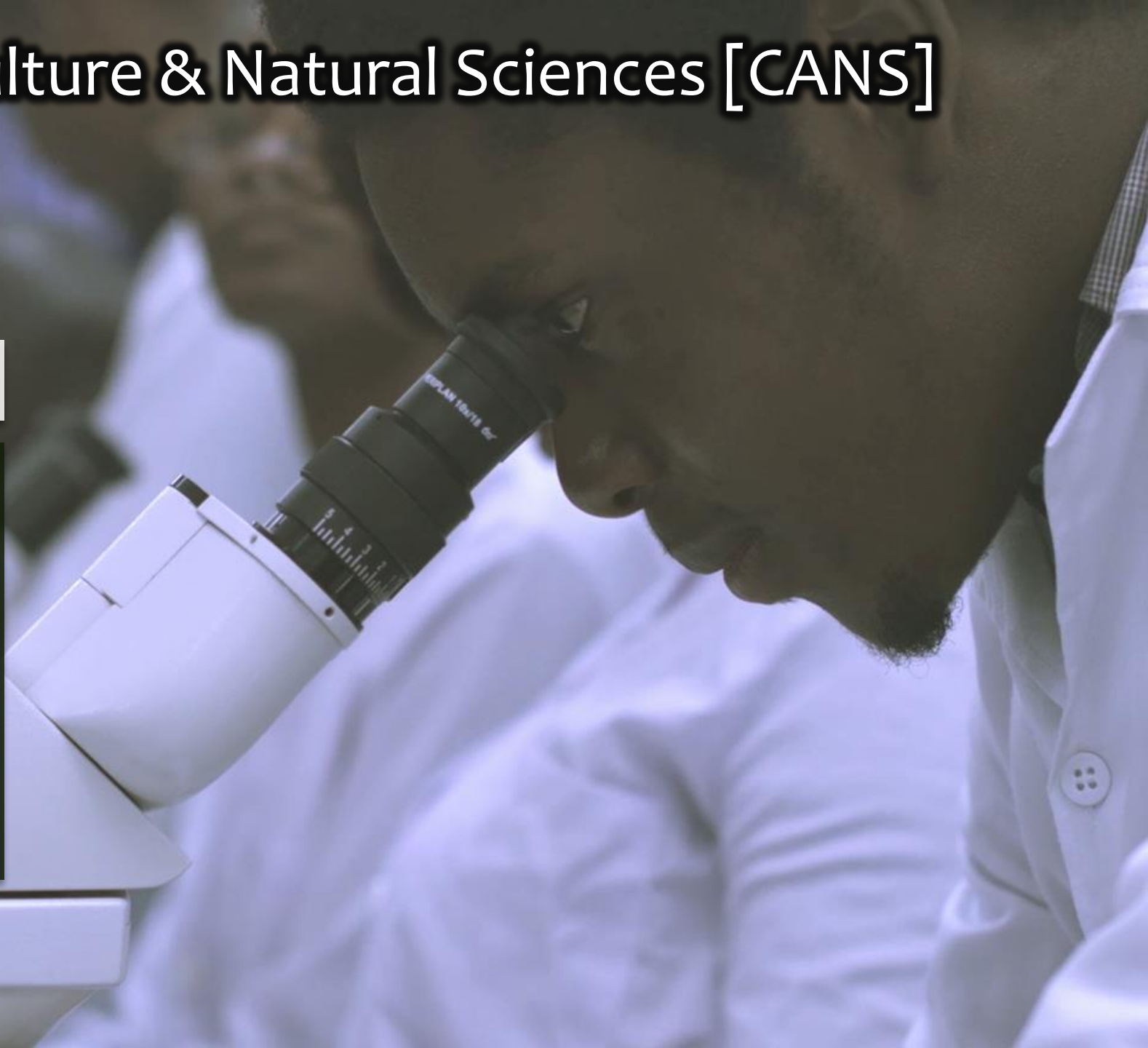

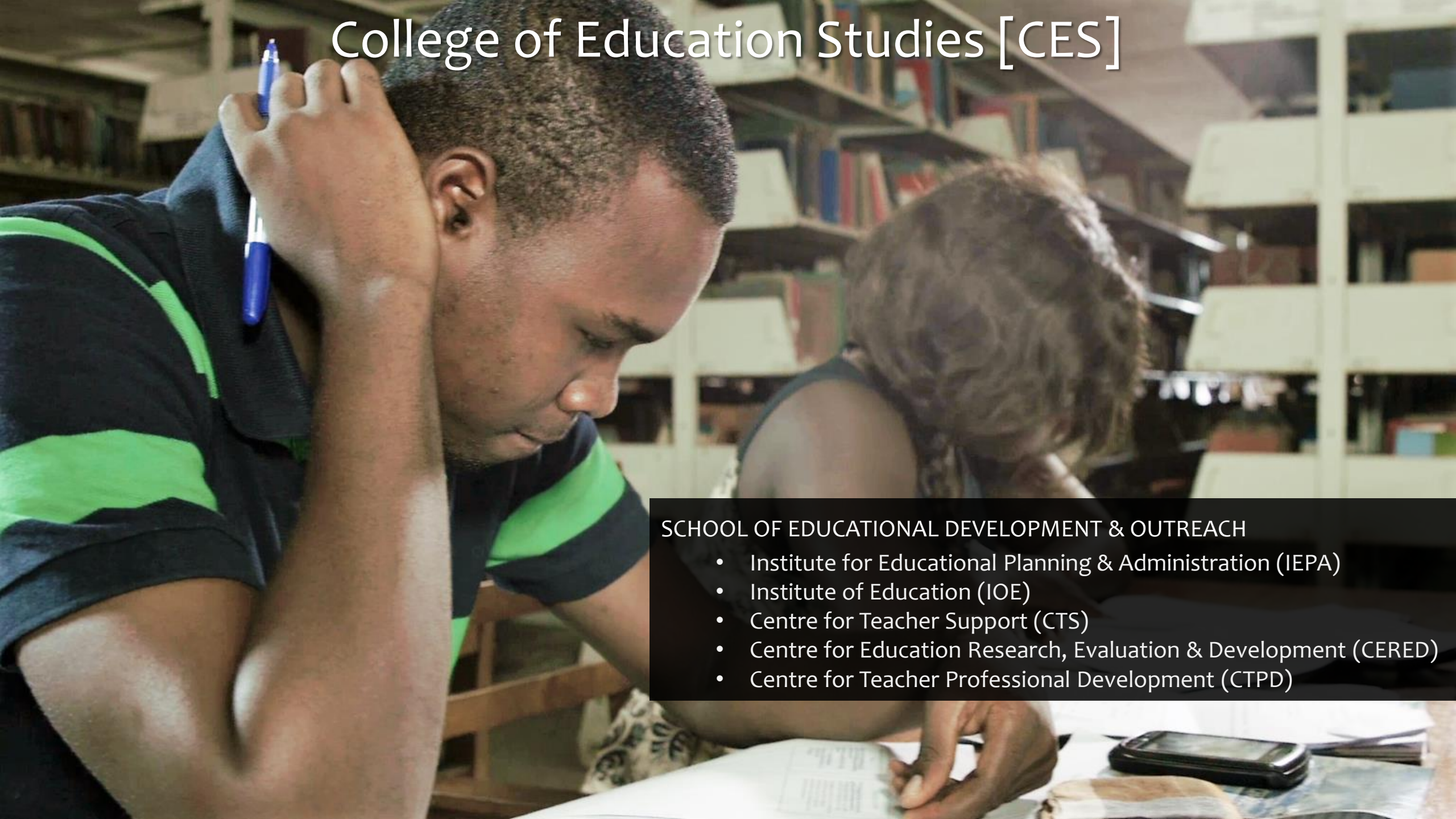

There are many sports and amalgamated clubs that students can join on campus.

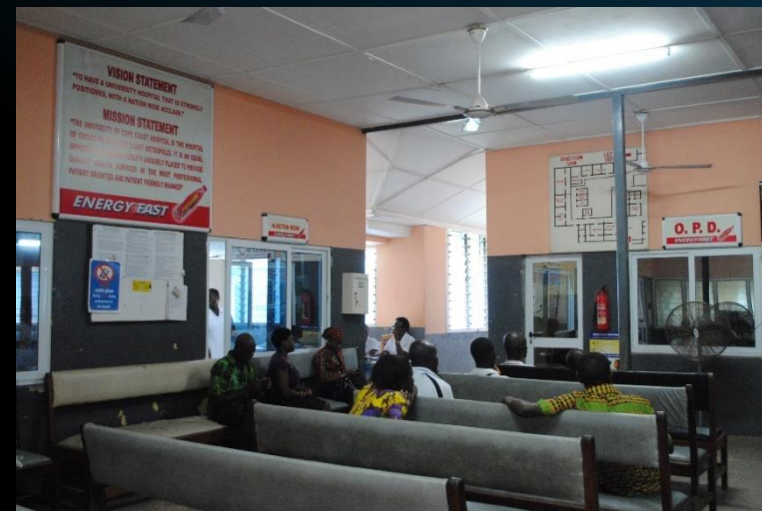
The University is a secular institution and it embraces religious groups of all kinds.
